Asbestos

Asbestos consists of naturally occurring mineral fibres and has been used in many materials owing to its unique properties, including pipe lagging, sprayed coatings, ceiling tiles, roof panels and water tanks. Inhalation of asbestos fibres can lead to diseases of the chest and lungs and is responsible for approximately 3000 deaths per year, more than any other work-related cause.
